Baganda – Central Uganda, known for Buganda Kingdom heritage

Batwa – Indigenous forest people near Bwindi, offering cultural encounters

Karamojong – Semi-nomadic pastoralists in the northeast

Banyankole – Famous for long-horned Ankole cattle

Acholi & Langi – Northern Uganda, rich in music and dance traditions

Travelers can experience cultural tours, homestays, and performances that add depth to their safari.

Dry Seasons (June–Sept, Dec–Feb):Best for gorilla trekking & game drives

Wet Seasons (Mar-May, Oct-Nov): Lush scenery, fewer tourists, discounted rates
